After School Activities

After school activities end January 11 and resume the week of Feb. 16 with the exception of Mad Science and Kids Fitness held on Tuesday afternoons which will continue. Parents should plan to collect their children by 2:30 or 12:30 respectively for this period of time.



Examinations are stressful for students but form an integral part of the assessment process. The value of examinations will vary but typically range from 15%-30% of a student's overall grade. Refer to the course outline provide the first day of classes to find out the value of the exam.

Attached is the examination schedule for student's grades 7-12. Please check it carefully and know when the examinations are being written. Students absent for exams will receive a grade of '0' unless medical documentation can be provided. Students arriving late will NOT be permitted extra time so make sure you plan your arrival time carefully. If a student does not have an exam on a day they are not required to attend school.

On the day your students are writing an exam they will be expected to:

Arrive prepared (pencils, pens, formula sheets if permitted etc...) **ELECTRONICS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED IN THE EXAM ROOMS**

Gr. 10-12 students should bring textbooks with them which will be returned to the teacher. Students not returning books will be responsible for the cost of replacing the books

Students will remain in the exam room for no less than 1 hour. Upon completing their exam grade 7-9 students are to report to study hall for the remainder of the day OR they may leave if a note has been provided to the school. Eg.
